Brazilian companies will be at the Expodefensa fair with their eyes set on the Latin American defense market

The Brazilian Defense and Security Industries Association will bring 17 of its associated companies to this year's last international fair

The Brazilian Defense and Security Industries Association (ABIMDE), in partnership with the Brazilian Trade and Investment Agency (Apex-Brasil), will be at Expodefensa with its associated companies. The fair takes place from December 4 to 6 in Bogota, Colombia, marking the end of the international fair calendar of 2017.

In this edition of Expodefensa, 17 member companies of ABIMDE will showcase their products and services to the Latin American defense and security market. The Brazil Pavilion joins about 250 exhibitors from 26 countries. In its 2015 edition, the fair received over 10,300 visitors from 34 countries and 55 official delegations from 27 countries, as well as defense ministers of many South American countries.

At the Brazil Pavilion, visitors will receive information on innovations in the national industry for the sea, air and ground segments. The Brazilian companies will present solutions for lethal and non-lethal weaponry, ballistic protection, command and control systems, radars, built-in systems, captive balloons, unmanned air vehicles, launchers, cybersecurity solutions, simulators and much more, everything featuring the most advanced technologies.
