With more than 12,500 professional visitors over three days, Expodefensa 2017 is positioned as one of the leading trade shows in the Defense and Security sector in Latin America.

This sixth edition of more than 12,000sqm exhibiting area held at the International Business and Exhibition Center of Bogota was organized for the second time by CODALTEC, COGES International and CORFERIAS and supported by MINDEFENSA.

Among Expodefensa 2017 participants:

- 74 Official Delegations from 30 countries
- 269 exhibitors from 34 countries, 72% international and 28% Colombian

This exhibition allowed exhibitors to present the latest technological products and innovations adapted to the defense and security needs of the Latin America and the Caribbean region.


Among the Functions of heads of Official Delagations
