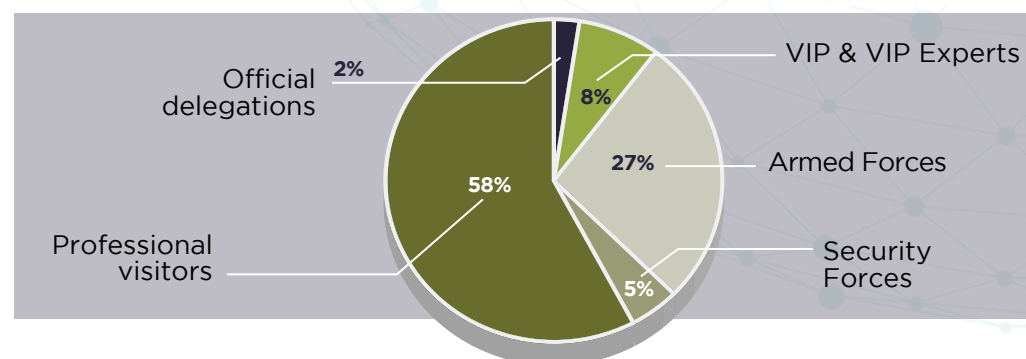

2019 EXPODEFENSA VISITORS CATEGORIES

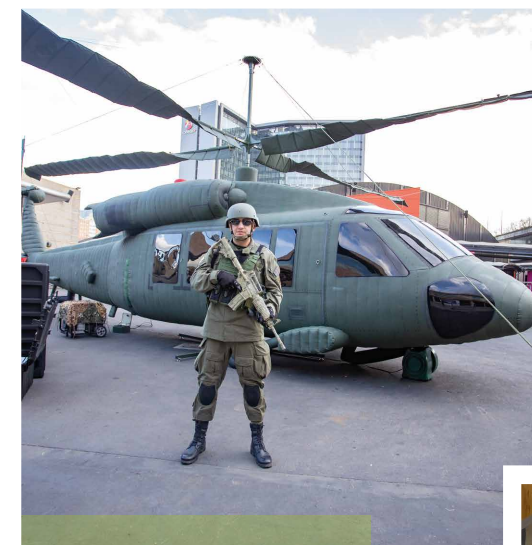


15 conferences and exhibitor workshops

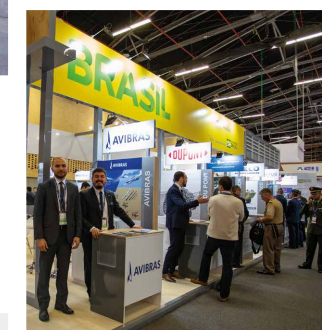
